



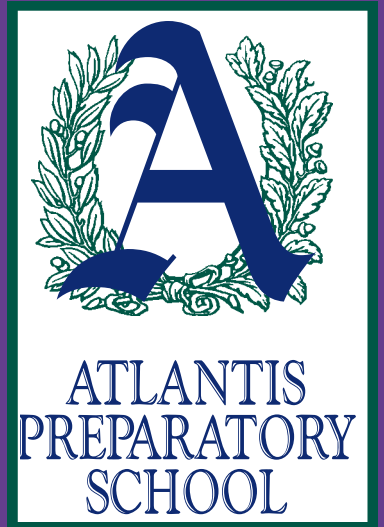

STORYBOOK BEARS

Sectioning for the math classes will be determined through the results of preliminary testing conducted during the first two sessions of class.
